Fertilizer

- Nitrogen (N): 110% in comparison to medium early varieties. (indication 275 kg N inclusive of soil
- Apply 2/3 before planting and 1/3 as top dressing.
- Phosphate (P) and Potassium (K): according to standard advice.

Pre-treatment and planting

- DELIA RED has a good dormancy.
- Pre-sprouting helps to advance the growth.
- Allow the seed to acclimatize to the local conditions before planting.
- DELIA RED can be grown on all soil types.
- On heavy soils a good structure is needed to avoid misshapen tubers.
- DELIA RED is tolerant to little potato disorder, planting can take place early.
- When potatoes from spring crop are used as seed for autumn/winter crop, this seed should not be stored cold.
- Apply a soil treatment against Rhizoctonia on sensitive soils.



Growing attention points

- Emergence is uniform with a good foliage development.
- DELIA RED has a good tolerance to metribuzin.
- Too much irrigation late in the season increases the dominance of lenticels.
- Use a robust Phytophthora programme, to prevent foliage and tuber blight
- Use later in the season products with strong tuber protection against tuber blight.
- Sensitive to Phytophthora in the haulm and tuber.



Haulm killing and harvest

- For optimum dormancy, ensure the crop is senescing before killing the haulm.
- To keep a bright and smooth skin, the tubers should not be left too long in the soil after haulm killing.
- The skin should be fully set before harvest.



Storage

- DELIA RED has a good dormancy, therefore ambient storage can be used for the first months after harvest
- Dry quickly after harvest and keep dry to help prevent silver scurf.
