

### **Fertilizer**

- Always refer to the current local rules about crop fertilization.
- Nitrogen (N): Medium inputs (170-210Kg N/Ha inclusive of soil supply).
- Phosphate (P) and Potassium (K): according to standard advice.

## General production advice ware potatoes



### Pre-treatment and planting

- LIBRA has a medium dormancy.
- Always treat LIBRA seeds against Rhizoctonia.
- LIBRA can be grown on all soil types.
- Planting with small white sprouts produces the best results.
- Preferably grow on irrigated land.



#### **Growing attention points**

- The use of metribuzin is recommended before emergence. When applying post emergence, use the low dose system.
- Maintain adequate soil moisture for good yield and quality.
- Use a robust Phytophthora programme, to prevent foliage blight.



### Haulm killing and harvest

- When temperatures are above 25°C; harvest early in the morning / by night is prefered.
- The skin should be fully set before harvest.
- Minimum 3 weeks between haulm killing and crop lifting for right skin set.



#### **Storage**

- LIBRA is an early variety and therefore sales are normally within 5 months after harvest.
- Take care of the wound healing period.
- Storage temperature: 4 °C.
- To ensure good presentation, LIBRA must avoid unnecessary exposure to light.
