

Fertilizer

- Adapt fertilization to soil analysis.
- Always refer to the local and current rules about crop fertilization.
- Nitrogen (N): Medium inputs (170-210Kg N/Ha inclusive of soil supply).
- Phosphate (P) and Potassium (K): according to standard advice.
- TALENTINE is susceptible to mineral deficiencies, therefore fertilize with trace elements.
- Manganese and magnesium will encourage a strong foliage and prevent premature senescence.

Pre-treatment and planting

- Warm up correctly the seed and plant it with small white sprouts.
- Always treat TALÉNTINE seeds against Rhizoctonia.
- Plant into warm soils, don't plant too early.
- Plant large seed deeper to avoid greening.
- Take care of a good volume ridge to prevent green tubers.




Growing attention points

- The use of metribuzin is recommended before emergence. When applying post emergence, use the low dose system.
- Irrigation results in a more uniform product with better cooking quality.
- Use a robust Phytophthora programme, to prevent foliage blight.



Haulm killing and harvest

- Aim for a dry matter content of 19 %.
- Minimum 3 weeks between haulm killing and crop lifting for right skin set.
- Reduce belt speed and height crop to reduce mechanical damage.
- Lift only when soil conditions are optimum.



Storage

- With a proper store management, TALENTINE is suitable for long term storage.
- Storage temperature: 4 °C.
- Reduce temperature 0,5 0,7 degrees a day, not lower than 4°C store temperature.
- Ventilate regularly, but briefly, to prevent CO2 accumulation.
- Any fluctuation in temperature, combined with condensation, can result in early sprouting and a high risk of Silver scurf.
- Before packing, warm up correctly the tubers to reach an internal stable value of 10°C 12°C.
