

### **Fertilizer**

- Adapt fertilization to soil analysis.
- Determinacy Group 3 for RB209
- Apply 2/3 before planting and 1/3 as top dressing.
- First top dressing of nitrogen directly after tuber initiation.
- Nitrogen (N): High inputs (210-250Kg N/Ha inclusive of soil supply).
- Phosphate (P) and Potassium (K): according to standard advice.

### Pre-treatment and planting

- VICTORIA has a good dormancy.
- Allow the seed to acclimatize to the local conditions before planting.
- Always treat VICTORIA seeds and soil against Rhizoctonia.
- VICTORIA can be grown on all soil types.
- Plant seed free from condensation to prevent disease contamination.
- Planting with small white sprouts produces the best results.



### **Growing attention points**

- VICTORIA grows spread in the ridge.
- Emergence is normal.
- VICTORIA is susceptible to metribuzin, also when applied before emergence.
- VICTORIA is high resistant to TRV.



## Haulm killing and harvest

- The skin should be fully set before harvest.
- VICTORIA is moderately susceptible to bruising. Reduce drop heights and avoid mechanical damage.



### **Storage**

- VICTORIA has a long dormancy and has good storability.
- Take care of the wound healing period.
- Store at a stable 8 °C.
- Ventilate regularly, but briefly, to prevent CO2 accumulation.
- For long term storage it is necessary to use sprout inhibitors.
